

BATTLE OF THE BANDS 2010
RULES

1. The competition is open to all ages.
2. One or more of the band members must live, work or go to school within the Horsham District.
3. Musicians with recording contracts or in professional bands cannot enter.
4. Original bands must be prepared to take part in a heat at the Chameleon Club Sunday 3rd, 10th, 17th and 24th October 2010 and if successful in the Grand Final, which will be held on the Carfax Bandstand on **Friday 29th October 2010**.
5. Covers bands must be available to perform on 7th November and Acoustic performers must be available to perform on 14th November, both at the Holbrook Club, North Heath Lane, Horsham.
6. The final will take place on Horsham Carfax Bandstand 18:00 – 22:00 on **Friday 29th October 2010**.
7. If the weather is bad the event will be switched to the Drill Hall in Denne Road.
8. Two members from each band must be prepared to attend an event briefing in Park Barn, North Street, Horsham at 19:00 on Tuesday 28th September 2010
9. There must be no swearing, smoking or drinking on stage*. Any band member who appears to be worse for drink or under the influence of drugs will not be allowed to perform. Please also refrain from directing the audience or inciting violence.
10. Nothing must be thrown from the stage, this includes yourselves.
11. Bands must stick to their allocated playing time. This will be 20 minutes. You must be ready to go onstage as soon as the preceding band has finished and have 10 minutes set up time. If you overrun the set up time, your playing time will be reduced.
12. Previous winners of the event will not be allowed to take part unless as an individual playing in a completely different band.
13. Bands must decide whether they wish to enter the covers, originals or songwriters section of the competition. If your set is a mixture of covers and originals you will be prejudiced within the originals section because of the judging criteria.
14. Bands playing original material will be judged on the basis of originality, stage presence, content, musicianship and audience reaction. The judges are aware that some bands bring larger followings than others! If bands play cover versions they will receive no points for originality.
15. Bands can ask for a copy of judge's scores and comments to be sent to them after the event.
16. The original section final will comprise of at least 6 bands. The winner and runner-up from each heat is guaranteed a place in the final. The running order for all heats and finals will be drawn by lot.
17. The closing date for entries is Friday 17th September 2009.
18. The judge's decision is final.

* The 'no-swearing' rule has been relaxed for the Chameleon Club heats only in that swear words are allowed as long as it is considered 'art' i.e. within the context (lyrics) of a song. For the Heats at the Holbrook Club and the Final in the Carfax Rule 9 applies in its entirety. Gratuitous foul language will obviously not be tolerated anywhere anytime.
